New York Intellectual Property Law Association

The New York Patent Law Association was formed on March 7, 1922. The Association, presided over by William Houston Kenyon, launched into an ambitious program of activities, including support of the Lehlbach Bill, investigation of post-war revival of the Patent Treaty with Germany, and encouragement of improvements in the quarters of the federal courts in New York City.

The Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary

The first Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary (Judges Dinner) was held on December 6, 1922 at the Waldorf Astoria New York Hotel. It was a rousing success with 258 people in attendance, including Judges Augustus and Learned Hand. The tradition continues tonight with an attendance exceeding 1,000 members and guests, as the New York Intellectual Property Law Association celebrates its One Hundred and First Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary.

Continuing Legal Education

Since 2000, the Association has been an accredited CLE provider for a wide variety of IP programs. The Association sponsors educational programs throughout the year, including monthly CLE and networking events. The Association's Annual Meeting & Awards Dinner will be held on May 10, 2023.

Our Active Role in the IP Community

The Association continued its strong history of representing its diverse intellectual property constituency before the courts through the activity of its Amicus Briefs Committee, which coordinates the activities of the Association in the preparation and filing of *briefs amicus curiae*.

Since the last Judges Dinner on March 25, 2022, Amicus Briefs Committee members (along with members of the Copyright Law & Practice and Trademark Law & Practice Committees) participated in the preparation and filing of four amicus briefs before the United States Supreme Court. The committee filed an amicus brief on the merits in support of neither party in *The Andy Warhol Foundation for the Visual Arts, Inc. v. Lynn Goldsmith*, regarding the appropriate test for “transformativeness” of a copyrighted work. The committee filed a brief on the merits in *In re Grand Jury*, a case that involved issues relating to whether a communication involving both legal and non-legal advice is protected by the attorney-client privilege when obtaining or providing legal advice was one of the significant purposes behind the communication. The committee also filed a brief on the merits in *Amgen Inc. v. Sanofi*, a case in which the Supreme Court will decide issues relating to the proper test for enablement of a claimed invention under 35 U.S.C. § 112. The committee also filed a brief on the merits in support of neither party in *Jack Daniel's Properties, Inc. v. VIP Products, LLC*, a case that involves issues relating to humorous use of another's trademark as one's own on a commercial product, and whether such use is subject to the Lanham Act's traditional likelihood of confusion analysis or instead receives heightened First Amendment protection.

During the past year, after oral argument, the Supreme Court dismissed the writ of certiorari in *In re Grand Jury* as “improperly granted,” leaving in place the Ninth Circuit’s holding that “the primary-purpose test applies to attorney-client privilege claims for dual-purpose communications.” The Supreme Court also denied certiorari in *American Axle & Manufacturing, Inc. v. Neapco Holdings LLC*, which involved issues related to patent eligibility under 35 U.S.C. § 101. The committee had filed a brief at the petition stage urging certiorari.

The Association’s participation in these cases ensured that the intellectual property community’s voice was heard by the courts in their deliberations on these important issues. The Amicus Briefs Committee will continue its commitment to represent the Association’s interests in all areas of intellectual property law in the courts to come.

Our Legislative Action Committee

The Legislative Action Committee (LAC) provides a voice on the important issues and challenges facing intellectual property practitioners and stakeholders by communicating the Association's views to Congress and federal agencies and interacting with Congress and various Executive agencies on IP-related laws, rules, and regulations. The LAC also provides analysis and guidance on proposed legislation and regulations of interest to NYIPLA members and works closely with American Continental Group (ACG), a public policy advocacy group.

Members of Congress grappling with complex IP concepts need effective, reliable and neutral resources to which they can turn. The LAC proudly serves as such a resource – helping members of Congress and their staffers to understand IP issues, to put them in appropriate perspective, and to better understand the implications that proposed legislation could have on the IP system and on the enforcement and defense of IP rights in the courts and in the patent office – so that Congress can, through appropriate legislation, help the IP system foster innovation as best it can. This need complements the diversity of the Association, whose members serve as outside and in-house counsel, representing a broad spectrum of interests, and having nationwide and global practices, with the advantage of being able to see all sides of an issue and without bias in favor of any particular industry.

Highlights of the LAC's work thus far for the 2022-2023 year include the following:

Our years-long effort to secure passage of the Daniel Anderl Judicial Security and Privacy Act came to its fruition when it was passed by Congress at the end of the last session and signed into law by President Biden.

We monitored the progress of legislation that passed (INFORM Act) and legislation that didn't (Pride in Patent Ownership Act).

We participated with the Corporate Committee in a discussion with Chris Israel of ACG relating to the changes in Congress and their likely impact on IP legislation. This legislative year could prove of great interest with new leadership in the Senate Judiciary Committee following Senator Leahy's retirement and the change in control of the House, with Rep. Issa assuming the chair of the House Judiciary subcommittee responsible for IP issues.

We also supported the January Presidents' Forum relating to the impact of the Inflation Reduction Act and other legislation on the pharmaceutical industry.

The LAC will continue to support NYIPLA by analyzing and providing input to the Board and guidance to legislators, their staff, and relevant agencies on these issues and other issues of interest to our members.

From the President



On behalf of the New York Intellectual Property Law Association (NYIPLA), I am pleased to welcome you to the 101st Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary. Tonight's event celebrates and honors everyone who provides service in the federal judiciary, from the District Courts to Appellate Courts, including Judges, Magistrate Judges, Court Clerks, Law Clerks and their staff. Every one of them performs critical work in the application and enforcement of our nation's laws, including the intellectual property laws that we all appreciate.

However, these are not the only people who make our judicial and administrative law systems the finest in the world. We appreciate and honor our State Court judges who are in attendance. We are most especially grateful and honored tonight to host the PTAB and TTAB Administrative Law Judges who keep the system working on a daily basis, including the Chief PTAB Judge Scott Boalick. We also honor our Administrative Law Judges and Commissioners from the International Trade Commission.

We also welcome the Congressional representatives who draft and enact the laws we all take part in administering. We are pleased to host a number of Congressional staff tonight including people from the Senate Judiciary Committee that oversees intellectual property laws.

Speaking of legislation, the NYIPLA is very proud to have supported the passage of the Daniel Anderl Judicial Security and Privacy Act. The genesis of this legislation was the cowardly and shameful attack on New Jersey District Judge Esther Salas and her family, in which her son Daniel Anderl was killed. The law aims to protect federal judges by safeguarding their personally identifiable information and that of their close relatives. NYIPLA Past-Presidents Colman Ragan, Robert Isackson, and I, working alongside Legislative Action Committee co-chair Anthony LoCicero and others, have tirelessly persuaded local congress members to support the passing of this important legislation for the past few years.

Tonight, we are pleased to be here for our second in-person dinner after the events of the pandemic separated us for two years. As many of you know, my theme for the year as President was to focus on the life sciences. There are guests in the audience tonight that I personally know in the pharmaceutical industry who contributed to the COVID-19 vaccines and treatments that made our recovery possible, and I am sure there are many others whom I do not know. I also hosted

a President's Forum on January 19th where thought leaders considered the impact of the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) on the pharmaceutical industry. We had speakers across the industry to discuss the public policy and economic reasoning both for and against the IRA and similar policies.

Now, as we celebrate the science and technology that helped us emerge from the pandemic and look to the future, I cannot imagine a better speaker than tonight's keynote, Dr. Mae Jemison. Dr. Jemison was the first African American Woman in Space onboard the space shuttle Endeavour in 1992, and is an inductee into the National Women's Hall of Fame & International Space Hall of Fame. She is also the Founder and President of two medical technology companies, the Jemison Group and BioSentient Corp. One reason she particularly appealed to me as a speaker this year is that she is also leader of the 100 Year Starship non-profit project, whose goal is to achieve human interstellar space travel within the next century. She has gathered cross-disciplinary teams to help understand the impact on humans as we engage in such long space voyages. She is an inspiration to us all as we celebrate our 100th year as an organization and look forward to the future.

I am also very proud to present the NYIPLA's Outstanding Public Service Award this year to Chief Judge Rodney Gilstrap of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas. Known by many as the country's "busiest patent judge," Chief Judge Gilstrap is a Baylor University Law School alumnus and 2011 appointee to the Court by former President Obama. His work in Marshall, Texas has shaped the state of patent litigation for a generation of patent lawyers. We are honored to give him this award.

I also would like to thank Feikje van Rein and her team from RRR Associations, for their hard work not just for organizing this dinner but also administering our programming, meetings, and events.

In addition, I would like to thank my colleagues and friends at my firm Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, for their NYIPLA support and participation over the years. Tonight, I am joined by friends in New York that I have known since my first year at the firm, as well as new friends in our Chicago, Washington, D.C., and San Francisco offices. I am proud to work alongside all of you.

Last but not least, I would like to thank my partner of over 25 years, Valentino Lee, my parents Richard and Beverly Schneider, and my brother and sister-in-law Ryan and Miki Schneider, for all of their love and support and faith in me over the years.

Outstanding Public Service Award



Honorable J. Rodney Gilstrap

Judge Rodney Gilstrap was nominated by President Barack Obama to serve as United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Texas, and was confirmed in 2011. He assumed the position of Chief Judge in 2018. He resides in Marshall, Texas and has responsibilities in the Marshall and Texarkana Divisions of the EDDTX. Prior to assuming the bench, Judge Gilstrap was engaged in private practice of law in East Texas for 30 years. During this time, he also was elected three times as County Judge of Harrison County, Texas. He holds BA *magna cum laude* from Baylor University where he was a member of Phi Beta Kappa. He also holds a JD from the Baylor University School of Law where he was an Associate Editor of the Baylor Law Review. He has served as President of the Baylor Law Alumni Association. In 2018 he was named “The Baylor Lawyer of the Year” -- the highest recognition given by his alma mater. He was also selected as the 2018 “Jurist of the Year” by TEX-ABOTA (comprising all 16 chapters in Texas of the American Board of Trial Advocates).

Dinner Speaker

Dr. Mae C. Jemison



Dr. Mae C. Jemison leads 100 Year Starship (100YSS), a bold, far reaching nonprofit initiative to assure the capabilities exist for human travel beyond our solar system to another star within the next 100 years. Jemison is building a multi-faceted global community to foster the cultural, scientific, social and technical commitment, support and financial framework to accomplish the 100YSS vision-*An Inclusive, Audacious Journey (that) Transforms Life Here on Earth and Beyond*. 100YSS programs include: Annual public conference *NEXUS*-Pathway to the Stars: Footprints on Earth; the Canopus Awards for Excellence in Interstellar Writing; the 100YSS Crucibles-Invitation only, transdisciplinary workshops to generate new disciplines to disrupt

technological and systemic hurdles; and 100YSS True Books to engage elementary students. The 100YSS Way Research Institute seeks to generate the radical leaps that accelerate knowledge, technology, design, and thinking not just for space travel, but to enhance life on Earth. Jemison led the team that won the competitive, single awardee seed funding grant in February 2012 from premiere research agency DARPA.

Jemison, the first woman of color in the world to go into space, served six years as a NASA astronaut. Aboard the Space Shuttle Endeavour, STS-47 Spacelab J mission in September 1992, she performed experiments in material science, life sciences and human adaptation to weightlessness.

Jemison started The Jemison Group, Inc. (JG) a technology consulting firm integrating critical socio - cultural issues into the design of engineering and science projects, such as satellite technology for health care delivery and solar dish Stirling engine electricity in developing countries. JG researches and develops stand-alone

science and technology companies. BioSentient Corporation, a medical devices and services company focused on improving health and human performance is such a company. An Environmental Studies professor at Dartmouth College, Jemison worked on sustainable development and technology design particularly for the developing world. Before joining NASA, she was the Area Peace Corps Medical Officer for Sierra Leone and Liberia and a general practice physician in Los Angeles.

In 1994 Jemison founded the international science camp The Earth We Share™ (TEWS) for 12-16 year old students from around the world, a program of the non-profit Dorothy Jemison Foundation for Excellence (DJF). From 2011 to 2014, DJF held TEWS-Space Race in collaboration with the Los Angeles Unified School District training hundreds of middle school teachers in experiential science education and over thousands of middle school students. Other foundation programs include *Reality Leads Fantasy - Celebrating Women of Color in Flight* that highlighted women in aviation and space from around the world. EXPO Inspire is a hands-on public STEM fair. LOOK UP™ announced in September 2017 an international movement to galvanize people worldwide, on a single day, to acknowledge that we are Earthlings.

Jemison was Bayer Corporation USA's national science literacy ambassador. She is one of the series hosts for National Geographic's "One Strange Rock" and space operations advisor for its global miniseries MARS.

Jemison is a member of the U.S. National Academy of Medicine and is on the boards of directors of Kimberly-Clark, the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards and the Texas Medical Center. She was the Founding Chair of the Texas state Product Development and Small Business Incubator Board, Chair of the Texas State Biotechnology and Life Sciences Industry Cluster, Chair of the Greater Houston Partnership Disaster Planning and Recovery Task Force, and served on the board of Scholastic, Inc. and Valspar Corporation. Jemison is a inductee of the National Women's Hall of Fame, the National Medical Association Hall of Fame and Texas Science Hall of Fame, International Space Hall of Fame as well as a recipient of the National Organization for Women's Intrepid Award, The Kilby Science Award and National Association of Corporate Directors' Directorship 100 most influential people in the boardroom in 2014, Honorary member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority and the New York Academy of Sciences, among many honors. She was a featured panelist on the CNBC special "The Business of Science" (9/2011) and was one of the teachers on "The Dream School." Jemison is an author including *Find Where the Wind Goes: Moments from My Life* True Books series on space exploration. She was the first real astronaut to appear on Star Trek TV series and is a LEGO figurine in the LEGO Women of NASA kit.


Lenten Dispensation
