Lenten Dispensation

A dispensation from the Lenten obligation to abstain from meat has been granted by the Archdiocese of New York to all Catholics attending the New York Intellectual Property Law Association's Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary, scheduled for March 22, 2024. There is a serious obligation for Catholics to observe abstinence from meat on Lenten Fridays in a substantial way. Therefore, those who are dispensed should substitute another fitting penitential practice in its place, especially a work of charity, prayer, or personal sacrifice.
