The Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary

The first Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary (Judges Dinner) was held on December 6, 1922 at the Waldorf Astoria New York Hotel. It was a rousing success with 258 people in attendance, including Judges Augustus and Learned Hand. The tradition continues tonight with an attendance exceeding 1,000 members and guests, as the New York Intellectual Property Law Association celebrates its One Hundred and Third Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary.

Continuing Legal Education

Since 2000, the Association has been an accredited CLE provider for a wide variety of IP programs. The Association sponsors educational programs throughout the year, including monthly CLE and networking events. The Association's Annual Meeting & Awards Dinner will be held on May 7, 2025 at The Union League Club.

Our Active Role in the IP Community

The Association continued its strong history of representing its diverse intellectual property constituency before the courts through the activity of its Amicus Briefs Committee, which coordinates the activities of the Association in the preparation and filing of briefs *amicus curiae*.

Since the last Judges' Dinner on March 22, 2024, Amicus Briefs Committee members participated in the preparation and filing of an amicus brief in *Cellect, LLC v. Vidal*, urging the Supreme Court to grant Cellect's petition for certiorari in a closely followed case involving issues concerning the interplay between obviousness-type double patenting and patent term adjustment. The committee also led the preparation of the Association's comments regarding the USPTO's proposed rule on terminal disclaimers filed to obviate obviousness-type double patenting rejections. After receiving more than 300 comments from stakeholders, including NYIPLA, the USPTO withdrew the proposed rule.

The Committee has 20 official members, but additional members of the Association and other committees have participated in our monthly meetings over the past year. Twelve Association members contributed as authors on the amicus briefs discussed above.

During the past year, the Federal Circuit issued an en banc decision in *LKQ Corp., et al., v. GM Global Tech. Ops. LLC*, in which the Association filed a brief on the merits in support of neither party urging the court to adopt a more flexible approach to assessing the patentability of design patents. The Federal Circuit threw out a longstanding test, known as the *Rosen-Durling* test, for determining whether a design patent is obvious. This decision was in line with the position for which the Association advocated—namely, providing clarity that the same conditions for patentability that apply to utility patents also apply to design patents. The Federal Circuit even acknowledged the substantial briefing by amici.

The Association's participation in these cases ensured that the intellectual property community's voice was heard by the courts and the USPTO. The Amicus Briefs Committee will continue its commitment to represent the Association's interests in all areas of intellectual property law in the courts in the year to come.

Our Legislative Action Committee

The Legislative Action Committee (LAC) provides a voice on the important issues and challenges facing intellectual property practitioners and stakeholders by communicating the Association's views to Congress and federal agencies, and by interacting with Congress and various Executive agencies on IP-related laws, rules, and regulations. The LAC also provides analysis and guidance on proposed legislation and regulations of interest to NYIPLA members and works closely with American Continental Group (ACG), a public policy advocacy group.

Members of Congress grappling with complex IP concepts need effective, reliable and neutral resources to which they can turn. The LAC proudly serves as such a resource – helping members of Congress and their staffers to understand IP issues, to put those issues in the appropriate perspective, and to better understand the implications that proposed legislation could have on the IP system and on the enforcement and defense of IP rights in the courts and in the patent office. In this way, Congress can, through appropriate legislation, help the IP system foster innovation. This need complements the diversity of the Association, whose members serve as outside and in-house counsel, representing a broad spectrum of interests, and having nationwide and global practices, with the advantage of being able to see all sides of an issue and without bias in favor of any industry.

Highlights of the LAC's work thus far for the 2024-2025 year include the following:

- We are carefully monitoring and will participate in the efforts to amend the AIA with respect to PTAB procedures (The PREVAIL Act) and to clarify the standards of patent eligibility (PERA). In particular, we work with the PTAB Committee on programs for Association members. We are monitoring the progress of legislation to create a rebuttable presumption of entitlement to an injunction after a finding of patent infringement (PERA).
- We also supported the 2024 Patent Law One Day program by presenting a session on pending legislation.

The LAC will continue to support NYIPLA by analyzing and providing input to the Board and guidance to legislators, their staff, and relevant agencies on these issues and other issues of interest to our members.

From the President



On behalf of the New York Intellectual Property Law Association (NYIPLA), I am pleased to welcome you to the 103rd Annual Dinner in Honor of the Federal Judiciary. Tonight, we celebrate and honor Judges, Magistrate Judges, Court Clerks, Law Clerks, Circuit and District Court Executives, and the staff of the Federal Courts. We honor each of them for their great service to our nation. The critical work that they do to interpret and apply the laws of our country, including the intellectual property laws, is of the utmost importance to providing justice to individuals and companies in support of our nation's great economy and reputation around the world.

We also welcome the Congressional representatives and Congressional staff including delegates from the Senate Judiciary Committee that handles the legislative process for intellectual property laws.

We celebrate many other honored guests in attendance tonight from the NY State Court, as well as leaders and distinguished guests from the USPTO. We are especially appreciative of the PTAB Administrative Law Judges, Administrative Law Judges, Court of Federal Claims Judges, and Commissioners of the International Trade Commission, that have so often demonstrated that they are fully committed and engaged in their role in ensuring that the intellectual property laws achieve the constitutional rights articulated in the U.S. Constitution Art. I, Sec. 8, Cl. 8., “To promote the progress of science and useful arts, by securing for limited times to authors and inventors the exclusive right to their respective writings and discoveries.”

Over 100 years ago, the NYIPLA was created as an organization through which patent lawyers in New York could make their views known in Washington and provide support for the judiciary. In 1922, the NYIPLA, then presided over by William Houston Kenyon, launched into an ambitious program of activities including the support of IP related proposed legislation, the investigation of post-war revival of the Patent Treaty with Germany, and the encouragement of improvements in the quarters of the federal courts in New York City. Today, the NYIPLA continues to fulfill its mission to provide commentary and support

for proposed legislation and to promote the development and administration of intellectual property interests by educating the public and members of the bar on issues of concern in the field of intellectual property law. The NYIPLA also continues to work with foreign associations to harmonize the substance and interpretation of international rules and conventions for the protection of intellectual property rights around the globe.

While we no longer advocate for improvements in the quarters of the federal courts, we do champion and promote laws that make a difference in the lives of the judiciary. The NYIPLA supported the passage of the Daniel Anderl Judicial Security and Privacy Act to protect federal judges by safeguarding their personal identifiable information. The NYIPLA Board, Legislative Action Committee, and Past Presidents Anthony Lo Cicero, Colman Ragan, Robert Isackson, and Heather Schneider worked ardently to persuade local congress members in support of this legislation to protect members of the judiciary and their families.

Tonight, we have the privilege of hearing from New Jersey District Court Judge Esther Salas as our Keynote Speaker. Judge Salas has served as a district court judge since 2011. She is the first Hispanic woman to serve as a United States District Court Judge in the District of New Jersey. “Daniel’s Law” was named in honor of her son. Judge Salas is known for bravery in speaking up for change in a time of unspeakable tragedy for herself and her family. She continues to educate the public about the dangers that judges face, and we are so grateful that she is here tonight.

Tonight, I am also overjoyed to present the NYIPLA’s Outstanding Public Service Award to the Honorable Jimmie V. Reyna of the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. Judge Reyna is known to many for his inspirational journey to the bench and his expertise in trade law. He is a loyal supporter of bar organizations and is recognized by many, including myself, for his sage advice to practitioners on excellence in advocacy before the courts. We are honored to acknowledge him with this award for his many contributions.

NYIPLA is honored to have so many firms, IP related organizations, members of IP Inns of Court, and companies represented here tonight. If you are not already an active member of the NYIPLA, we invite you to join us to invigorate our ranks that are now almost 1,000 voices strong. Thank you for continuing to support the NYIPLA!

I would also like to thank the current NYIPLA Board and past presidents for their hard work and dedication to continuing to pursue the mission of the NYIPLA.

Outstanding Public Service Award

The Honorable Jimmie V. Reyna

Jimmie V. Reyna was appointed to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit by President Barack Obama in 2011. He was confirmed by the Senate 86 to 0. Prior to his appointment, Judge Reyna was an international trade and customs attorney with Williams Mullen and a member of its board of directors. Before that, he was an associate and partner at the Washington law firm of Stewart and Stewart. Prior to locating in Washington, Judge Reyna was a solo practitioner in Albuquerque, New Mexico and, before that, an associate at an Albuquerque, New Mexico law firm.

Judge Reyna was appointed to and served on the U.S. roster of dispute settlement panelists for trade disputes under Chapter 19 of the North American Free Trade Agreement (1994–2011), and the U.S. Indicative List of Non-Governmental Panelists for the World Trade Organization, Dispute Settlement Mechanism, for disputes in both trade in goods and trade in services (1995–2011). Judge Reyna has authored two books, *Passport to North American Trade: Rules of Origin and Customs Procedures Under the NAFTA* (Shepards 1995), and *The GATT Uruguay Round, A Negotiating History: Services, 1986-1992* (Kluwer 1993), and numerous articles on international trade and customs issues, and in other areas of law. He was the founder and senior co-editor of the *Hispanic National Bar Association Journal of Law and Policy*.

Judge Reyna has worked throughout his career towards the positive development of the U.S. legal profession. He served in various leadership positions in the ABA Section on International Law and the Section on Dispute Settlement. He was a founder and member of the board of directors of the U.S.-Mexico Law Institute. He has provided over two decades of leadership in the Hispanic National Bar



Association, including serving as its National President (2006–07).

Judge Reyna is active in educational projects involving U.S. patent law. He has lectured in judicial ethics and rule of law training programs in Mexico (2017) and Colombia (2020). He has also lectured at the World Intellectual Property Organization (“WIPO”) Master Class on IP Adjudication, and Judicial Forums in Geneva, India, and Germany. He is currently serving as a member of the WIPO Advisory Board of Judges (2023–present).

Judge Reyna has received numerous awards, including the Ohtli Award (the highest honor bestowed by the Mexican government on a non-Mexican citizen), and has been recognized as among the nation’s 100 most influential Latino leaders by various publications. In 2015, the first intellectual property Inn of Court in Minnesota was founded, and it was named the Honorable Jimmie V. Reyna Intellectual Property American Inn of Court. In 2017, Judge Reyna received The Charles Force Hutchison and Marjorie Smith Hutchison Medal, the University of Rochester’s highest alumni award presented for career achievements and notable service. In 2018, he received The Hon. William C. Conner Inn Excellence Award. In 2022, Judge Reyna received the New Jersey Intellectual Property Law Association (NJIPLA)’s Jefferson Medal for his exceptional contributions to the field of intellectual property law.

Dinner Speaker

The Honorable Esther Salas, United States District Judge



Judge Salas earned her B.A. from Rutgers University and her J.D. from Rutgers School of Law-Newark. After graduating from law school, Judge Salas clerked for the Honorable Eugene J. Codey, Judge of the Superior Court, Essex County Vicinage. In October 1995, Judge Salas entered private practice with the law firm of Garces and Grabler, P.C., where she focused on criminal defense and appellate litigation. In September 1997, Judge Salas joined the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the District of New Jersey. As an Assistant Federal Public Defender, Judge Salas represented indigent criminal clients in front of both the New Jersey District Court and the Third Circuit.

On November 3, 2006, Judge Salas was sworn in as a Magistrate Judge for the District of New Jersey—the first attorney of Hispanic descent to hold that position. On June 14, 2011, the Senate unanimously confirmed President Obama’s nomination of Judge Salas as a United States District Judge. Judge Salas was sworn in by the Honorable Jose L. Linares, making her the first Latina District Judge in the District of New Jersey.

As a District Judge, Judge Salas has presided over complex civil and criminal cases, including a number of issues of first impression for the District of New Jersey. Additionally, Judge Salas, along with Senior District Judge Katharine S. Hayden, co-founded the District of New Jersey Pretrial Opportunity Program, which provides pre-trial judicial intervention for criminal defendants suffering from drug and alcohol addiction.

Judge Salas has been recognized for her work on and off the bench. She has received numerous awards, including the Whipple Memorial Award from the

Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers of New Jersey (2008), the Women's Initiative and Leaders in Law Platinum Award from the New Jersey Women Lawyers Association (2015), the Woman of Substance Award from Seton Hall University's Women's Law Forum (2015), the Public Interest Law Foundation Award from Rutgers University (2021), the President's Award from the Hispanic National Bar Association (2022), the Justice Thurgood Marshall Award from the New Jersey State Bar Association (2022), the Jurist Award for Making the World a More Just Place from the National Judicial College (2023), the William J. Brennan, Jr. Award from the Association of the Federal Bar of New Jersey (2023), the Excellence in Civic Engagement Award from the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at Stockton University (2023), the Raphael Lemkin Rule of Law Guardian Award from the Bloch Judicial Institute of Duke Law School (2024), and the Morton A. Brody Distinguished Judicial Service Award from Colby College (2024).

Judge Salas is a loving wife to her husband of 26 years, Mark Anderl, and the proud mother of her late son, Daniel Mark Anderl, who offered his life as an act of love when a disgruntled lawyer targeted Judge Salas because of her position as a federal judge. Since Daniel's senseless and tragic murder, Judge Salas has made it her mission to ensure greater protections for judges. Daniel's sacrifice, and Judge Salas's advocacy, led to the swift passage of "Daniel's Law" in New Jersey. To ensure that Daniel's death would not be in vain, Judge Salas advocated for federal legislation to ensure greater protections for federal judges. As a result of such advocacy, President Biden signed the Daniel Anderl Judicial Security and Privacy Act into law on December 23, 2022.


Lenten Dispensation
